



Dishwasher/Pots

- Ensure the dishwashing area is always clean and free of debris
- Report any damage, theft and abandoned articles to the Supervisor
- Follow sanitation policies at all times
- Adhere to safety policies and procedures by following company safe work practices and standard operating procedures
- Perform other duties as assigned

- Experience working in a kitchen is required
- Experience using a large industrial dishwasher is an asset
- Food Safety certification valid in the province of British Columbia for the duration of your employment is a requirement

- Excellent organizational and time management skills
- Must be able to move, lift, carry, pull, push, and place objects away weighing up to 50 lbs
