OFFICIAL STATEMENT:

Kitsumkalum focused on building and validating their eligible voters' mailing list during this year's election. The outcome of the number of voters was similar to what Kitsumkalum experienced during their last election with 228 ballots received this year compared to 233 ballots received during the previous election.

Though an All Candidates Forum was not hosted this year due to capacity and limited resources, Kitsumkalum has their youth undertake the planning of the All Candidates Forum in the past and are very keen on having them involved again during the next election permitting capacity and resources are available.
