Two (2) Kermode Highway Safety Monitors

Kermode Friendship Society is looking for two (2) individuals to work as temporary Kermode Highway Safety Monitors (KHSM) starting Jan 2, 2021. The KHSM monitors will work as a team and drive the local highways as far east as Smithers and be on the look out for individuals who are hitching. Using a harm reduction approach the team will provide food and warm clothing. Rides may be offered on the spot. This is a demonstration project and information collected will be used for ongoing programming to funders.

Job Duties

- Adheres and Enforces all Kermode Friendship Society published policies and procedures as per *Policy and Procedure Manual*;
- Drive highway 16 and related highways
- Offer support to individuals including but not limited to:
 - Hitchhiking alternatives
 - Assess to offer rides if appropriate that personal safety is not compromised
 - Create safety plans
 - Provide warm clothing and food as the need arises
- In the event of inclement weather, the monitors will provide support to clients in Terrace after hours

Position Requirements

- Must be able to work in Canada
- Valid Driver's License; and Drivers Abstract.
- Pass criminal record check
- First Aid Level 1;
- Food Safe Certificate;

Working Conditions

- Able to lift up to fourteen (14) kg;
- Long hours of driving in a vehicle and be comfortable in driving in the NW in winter conditions in most situations.
- Must be able to confidently respond to emergency situations quickly and effectively
- Hours of work are unsociable
