What is happening now?

Work is well underway!
Progress been made in the following areas:

- Creating a land inventory and database
- Registering various land transactions (such as Allotments/ CP's and transfers)
- Coordinating an Additions to Reserve (ATR) application
- Creating processes, procedures, and checklists for day-to-day activities.



Where do we go from here?

Some of the things we are working towards include:

- Establishing a Committee (this committee can be support to Staff and Council!)
- Land management training and capacity building
 - Working with the community to understand land issues and prioritize laws
 - Developing processes and procedures for handling land matters
