ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

- Ensures the highest sanitary standards are maintained in all areas of responsibility in accordance with company, client, and governmental requirements.
- Assists ESS crews as needed to support the project; including boosting morale of crew.
- Plans cleaning and work schedules.
- Establishes and/or adjusts work procedures to meet production schedules.
- Advises management of purchasing needs with a focus on minimizing dollars invested in physical inventories, operating at budgeted product costs, and avoiding product shortages.
- Ensures good order and maintenance of all equipment by immediately reporting any deficiencies to maintenance.
- Ensures company compliance with all permitting requirements and government regulations.
- Provides management with copies of any site-specific procedures that have been developed in performance of duties.
- Sorts, counts, folds, marks, carries linens, makes beds.
- Cleans lobbies, lounges, rest rooms, corridors, elevators, and stairways.
- Sweeps, scrubs, waxes, and polishes floor.
- Cleans rugs, carpets, upholstered furniture, and draperies.
- Dusts furniture.
- Washes walls, ceiling, and woodwork.
- Washes windows, door panels, and sills.
- Empties wastebaskets and empties and cleans ashtrays.

- Transports trash and waste to disposal area.
- Replenishes bathroom supplies.
- Obtains list of rooms that need to be cleaned.
- Inventories stock to ensure adequate supplies.
- Examines rooms, halls, and lobbies to determine need for repairs or replacement of furniture or equipment and makes recommendations to maintenance.
- Perform all duties in the safest possible manner and report all incidents and health & safety concerns to the supervisor or manager.
- All other duties as assigned.
