Who We Are: The Northwest Inter-Nation Family & Community Services Society "NIFCS" is an Aboriginal based agency that provides family support, guardianship and caregiver services to seven First Nations communities in the Northwest region of British Columbia. Our member communities are: Kitselas, Haisla Nation, Lax Kw'alaams Band, Gitxaala Nation, Gitga'at Nation, Kitsumkalum Indian Band, and Metlakatla First Nation

Background: Bill C-92 - *An Act respecting First Nations, Inuit and Métis children, youth and families* is an Act to affirm and recognize First Nations jurisdiction over child and family services.

Job summary:

This is a contract position demanding at a minimum 20 hours/week for a period of 4 months for Community Liaison Officers, ideally one for each of the seven member NIFCS communities, to interact with and provide information, translation, or training to people in the community on Bill C-92. The Community Liaison Officer will live in and be a member of the community and help coordinate educational sessions and provide written and verbal updates at local events and activities through social media channels or other communication avenues. Community Liaison Officers will be provided with necessary training materials and support to set up sessions or attend events.

Job duties:

- Participate in training and research related to Bill C-92 child and family jurisdiction
- Set up or participate in local community events to share information on Bill C-92 as directed by Elders, leadership, and youth so that they can better understand the scope of jurisdiction each community would like around Child and Family Services
- Manage communication and reporting between NIFCS and the community

Job qualifications:

- Experience in community outreach with a good understanding of the local community norms and culture
- Computer literacy in MS Office
- Flexibility to work any hours
- Excellent communication skills, both verbal and written
- Ability to work independently and within a team
- Proof of Covid-19 vaccination

This position will remain open until filled.

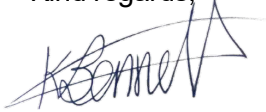
