The following are identified area(s) within Kitsumkalum where YOU must evacuate if given direction.

IN CASE OF TRAIN DERAILMENT OR HAZARDOUS GOODS SPILL:

EVACUATE TO KALUM QUARRY. Register all household individuals with designated emergency officials and then remain with the vehicle for accountability purposes. There will be emergency officials who will provide you with the next steps regarding the emergency.

IN CASE OF FLOOD OR WILDFIRE:

EVACUATE TO KITSUMKALUM COMMUNITY HALL. Please check in your **entire** household to the designated registrar at the entrance. The following information will be collected when you arrive.

- o Name (s)
- o Address (where you came from within Kitsumkalum)
- o Any important medical information
 - Follow the next steps provided by emergency officials

SHELTER IN PLACE:

Shelter in place means the following:

- Under NO circumstance will you leave your home
- Lock all doors, close all windows and openings
- Await direction from media or emergency officials

Examples of sheltering in place: Active shooter, bomb threat, unstable or predicted weather risk (s)

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO WHEN AN EVACUATION ALERT IS IN EFFECT:

- Gather essential items such as medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (i.e., insurance, ID cards), immediate
 care needs for dependents and, if you choose keepsakes (photographs, etc.). Have these items readily
 available for a quick departure.
- Move pets to a safe area if needed.
- Arrange to transport household members in the event of an evacuation order. Ensure the vehicle is driveable
 and has fuel.
- Arrange accommodation for your family if possible. In the event of an evacuation, emergency accommodation will be provided if required.
- Monitor the media and be prepared to follow the direction of emergency officials about where to evacuate to.

IF YOU HAVE TO EVACUATE:

- Take an emergency survival kit with you. This should be pre-packed and ready at any time.
- Make sure you take prescription medicine and identification for the entire family.
- Listen to the radio/media and follow instructions from local emergency officials.
- If you are instructed to do so, shut off water, gas, and electricity. Lock your home.
- Follow the routes specified by emergency officials. Don't take shortcuts. A shortcut could take you to a blocked or dangerous area. **Under no circumstances should you return home until instructed to do so.**
