There has been a significant increase in overdose events resulting from two distinct substances. Substance one sold as "down," is a light brown/beige color and has been causing prolonged sedation, breathing difficulties, strange behavior, and blackouts. The second substance is purple in color and has also been linked to overdoses.

### **Overdose signs** Choking, gurgling, or Slow or Lips are blue Nails are blue NO breathing snoring sounds Person is not moving Skin feels cold Pupils are tiny Can't be woken up or clammy

#### Have a Safety Plan

- Don't use alone
- If alone, use the Lifeguard or BeSafe app
- When possible avoid mixing drugs or mixing drugs with alcohol
- Carry and know how to use naloxone
- Test a small amount and go slow
- Call 9-1-1 or your local emergency number right away if someone overdoses
