Drug's characteristics:

CONTAINS:

There has been an increase in overdoses in Prince George linked to "brown sugar granules." Drug checking services indicated high levels of fentanyl (30%) and benzodiazepine (5-10%). Reportedly, it has been causing people to black out and behave unusually, consistent with benzodiazepine effects. Both fentanyl and benzodiazepine test strips have shown positive results.



Have a Safety Plan

- Don't use alone
- If alone, use the Lifeguard or BeSafe app
- When possible avoid mixing drugs or mixing drugs with alcohol
- Carry and know how to use naloxone
- Test a small amount and go slow
- Call 9-1-1 or your local emergency number right away if someone overdoses
