Curbside Collection Guidelines

- Materials should be curbside by 8:00 am on the designated collection day, and no earlier than 10:00 pm on the day before collection day.
- Weight limit: 23 kg/50 lbs per bin/bag.
- Place all containers within 2 m/6 ft of the roadway.
- Remove empty containers no later than 10:00 pm on collection day.
- · Do not tie down lids of containers.

Bi-weekly Garbage Collection

- Garbage must be bagged and placed in a rigid, waterproof can no larger than 121 L with a securely fitted lid.
- For extra garbage, bag tags can be purchased at the Regional District office for \$2 each in a group of 10. A maximum of 4 bag tags can be used per collection.
- Not Accepted in Garbage Collection: Recyclables, bulky items such as furniture, appliances, electronic products, liquids, and organic materials.

Bi-weekly Recycling Collection

- Use RDKS provided recycle bin
- Recycling is to be placed loose in the bin no bags




- · Rinse containers to remove food residue
- Flatten cardboard and place beside your recycling can in bundles not exceeding 1 cubic metre (36" X 36" X 36")
- Additional recycling may be placed in an extra bin that does not exceed 121 L

NOT ACCEPTED

If contaminants or unacceptable material is found in any of the waste streams, it may **NOT** be collected and marked with an 'Oops!' sticker. These stickers help you use the collection service correctly by identifying the issue. Please follow the stickers instructions or remove the unacceptable material so we can pick up your waste next time.

How To: Weekly Organics Collection

Container Size and Limit

 A maximum of six items may be placed at the curb each week, consisting of two containers with lids (which may contain kitchen waste and/or yard waste) and up to four kraft paper bags or bundles of yard waste.

- Each rigid container must be no more than 99 litres and 23 kg (50 lbs) when set out for collection.
